

Handball Rules To Follow

- Object of game is to throw the ball in the net and score points depending on where the shot was taken
- No one can go in goalie area except goalie, must notify referee of goalie change
- If you step into the goalie area (touch blue) your opponent is awarded a penalty shot from the 2 point area but the shot is only worth **1 point**.
- If you are pushed into the goalie area you are awarded a penalty shot worth **1 point**.
- Flagrant fouls are awarded penalty shots and may result in the player committing the foul being kicked out of the game or penalty minutes
- If the ball goes out of bounds the opposite team gets the ball
- You can dribble and pass the ball
- You **CAN NOT** walk or run with the ball
- If two players both have hands on the ball a jump ball is awarded
- After a score the goalie plays the ball out
- If the ball bounces back out of the net and into play you **CAN NOT** re-shoot the ball! Just toss the ball back to the goalie to start play!
- The referee keeps track of the score and oversees game
- If a goalie shoots from his own goal area and scores his team is awarded **3 points**.
- The goalie can come out of his area but if he does so, the goalie follows regular rules.
- If a player shoots from other than the 2 point area he is awarded **1 point**.
- If you shoot from red area extended you are awarded **2 points**.
